

PROTOCOL FOR COLLABORATION WITH OTHER USERS

Except for the civil sector organizations as part of the OPEN SPACE program, the space of Kino Kultura (KK) is also available for other users from the wider social context.

This protocol means regulating this type of collaboration that we agree to rely on the principles of democracy, equity, fairness, solidarity, mutual assistance, participation and respect for diversity. In the spirit of collaboration we believe in ethical values - sincerity, openness, transparency, social responsibility and care for others.

Terms of use

- They receive the space under contractual compensation for a day or several days of use, which is defined depending on the event and needs, which also includes current costs for space (electricity and maintenance). The price is defined depending on the event and needs
- Independently cover the technical needs for implementation
- Care for the promotion of their programs
- Organize their own additional activities (cocktail)
- Organize the security if necessary
- Sign a contract with a KK representative to use the space where the precise conditions are defined

Arbiter in case of a dispute for all previously defined situations is the Governing body of Kino Kultura.
